Accessibility:

The Enercare Centre (ECC) has been designed with accessible facilities for the following:

- Disabled persons: unisex and handicapped accessible washrooms, double meeting room doors, sidewalk curb cuts and heated ramps.
- Visual impaired: location and information signage with universal symbols of accessibility, Braille and raised letters, high colour contrasts; textural changes on exterior pavers, textured concrete in walk way areas and floor patterning.
- Hearing impaired: FM loop systems compatible with typical hearing aids in meeting rooms.
- Please note: although Canada Blooms encourages accessibility with our builders, some of our feature gardens may not be fully accessible.
